

British Occupational Hygiene Society ("BOHS") – Asbestos modules

P401 – Identification of asbestos in bulk samples – provides theoretical and practical knowledge in the techniques of asbestos sample identification using polarised light microscopy (PLM).

P402 – Building surveys and bulk asbestos sampling – provides background and practical knowledge in the surveying of buildings, together with general guidance on management procedures to minimise exposure to any identified asbestos.

P403 – Asbestos fibre counting – aimed at analysts to provide theoretical and practical knowledge in the techniques of fibre counting of asbestos air samples using phase contrast microscopy (PCM).

P404 – Air sampling of asbestos and MMMF and requirements for a certificate of reoccupation following clearance of asbestos – provides theoretical and practical knowledge in the techniques of air sampling and clearance testing of asbestos.

P405 – Management of asbestos in buildings – this module will provide the practical knowledge and skills to be able to manage asbestos in buildings and give a knowledge base to audit asbestos removal projects.

P406 – Supervision and management of the safe removal and disposal of asbestos – this module provides the practical knowledge and skills to be able to act as a supervisory licence holder as required by The Contractors' Guide.

S301 – Asbestos and other fibres – this comprehensive "specialist" module covers all of the proficiency modules, enhancing knowledge of occupational hygiene practice in relation to fibrous dusts.

Manual Handling

Work at Height Hazard Awareness – to raise awareness of hazards, safe working procedures and relevant legislation.

Asbestos Awareness – this course covers the syllabus for awareness training contained in the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006. We offer full and half-day courses.
